

### 3. HOW TO USE THE CONTROL PANEL

#### **ON/OFF** button

Press the OFF button to turn the device off.

#### SPEED button

When the device is plugged, press button LOW-MID-HIGH for speed selection.

#### COOL button

Press this button after adding cold water and ice trays to the tank. The ice trays must be in the freezer for at least 4 hours. This option allows the humidity of the room to be increased, helping to decrease the temperature. Place the frozen ice cube tray in the tank together with the water. The two ice cube trays can be used simultaneously or consecutively.

NEVER activate this function without water in the tank.

## 4. INSTALATION AND FUNCTIONING

Place the wheels of the evaporative air conditioner by applying pressure gently until it is correctly fitted, no tools are needed.


Connect to the electricity supply. Select the desired speed and mode.

To use the COOL function, follow the steps below to add water.

1) Turn the tank latch, remove the water tank

halfway <u>ONLY</u>, (the tank contains a safety device, if it is forced the open, it will be damaged, and is outside the warranty of the product). Pour in the cold water, taking care not to spill it (figure 3).

2 Fill depending on whether the ice cubes are going to be inserted or not.

- 3 Keep in mind the window with the water level on the back of the appliance.
- 4 Never exceed the Maximum level (MAX), or add water

- to below the Minimum level (MIN). (Figure 4).
- (5) If desired, add one or two ice trays to improve the cooling effect.
- 6 Push the tank carefully inwards. You have ready the device for use in the cold function.

# 5. HOW TO USE THE ICE TRAYS

The ice trays have the function of helping to keep cool the water that is added in the appliance. By cooling the water through which the air will filter in cool mode the ambient temperature of the room is reduced.

## Method of use:

- a. Put the ice tray full of water in the freezer and wait until they are completely frozen to use them.
- b. Put cold water in the water tank and introduce one of the ice trays.
- c. Once the ice tray has thawed, take it out and introduce the other one. If desired, insert the two ice trays into the tank at the same time, always taking into account the MAX water quantity level.

## 6. ATTENTION

- 1. The item is for household use only and using at same voltage and frequency.
- 2. Use the item in a well-ventilated area.
- 3. Do not operate the appliance with wet hands in order to avoid

- hazard.
- 4. If the power cord is damaged it must be replaced by the service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 5. When the item is not in use please switch it off or unplug it.
- 6. Do not insert external things to air outlets and inlets in order to avoid damage. Do not put heavy articles on the top of the item.
- 7. Do not use the item near explosive and combustible gas. Avoid long-term direct solar radiation. Do not locate the item directly below the socket-outlet and outdoor. Do not use the same socket with other items.
- 8. Do not let water exceed the "MAX" scale at any time. When operating the item, the water should not be below "MIN" scale.
- 9. After adding water to the water tank, do not tilt or knock over it when move the item. If you want to move, push it slowly from the side in order to avoid spilling.
- 10. Do not make the wind outlet be too close to the wall, curtain and so on. It will block the air flow and affect the wind effect. Do not cover the wind outlet.
- 11. Keep the item over 20 cm against the wall or other articles.
- 12. Switch off the power before you wash or examine and repair the item.
- 13. When you clean the surface of the item using the soft wet cloth, do not use corroded liquid or solvent. Make sure that do not pour water on to the item.
- 14. If you find that noise appears or the wind is asymmetry after using for a long time, please wash the filter net.
- 15. Do not wobble or knock the item when it is running, otherwise it maybe stops by itself. Thus restart the item.
- 16. The water in tank will be easily metamorphosed and diffuse odor in summer. Pls renew the water frequently.
- 17. This item is not intended for use by children, persons with reduced physical sensory or mental capabilities, unless they

- have been given supervision by a person responsible for their safety.
- 18. Do not use this heater in the immediate surroundings of a bath room or a swimming pool.

## 7. CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

ATTENTION: disconnect from the power supply before cleaning the appliance. Never pour water on the control panel.

Cleaning the air filter (Figure 5)

This cleaning is done after the end of the usage season. Disconnect the appliance from the electricity supply, remove the screws from the back cover and remove the external air filter. Also remove the inner filter. Clean it with a brush and neutral detergent. Once clean and dry, reinsert it.

## Cleaning the internal fan.

Once the filters have been removed, remove any accumulated dust from the fan with a damp cloth.

### Cleaning the tank.

Disconnect from the power supply, open the tank <a href="https://example.com/halfway">halfway</a>, (the tank contains a safety device, if it is forced open, it will be damaged, and is outside the warranty of the product). Turn the appliance over to remove the water and clean with a damp cloth and detergent.

## Cleaning the body of the device

Clean with a neutral detergent or simply with clean water and a soft cloth only if there are any marks.
