• COOLER MAINTENANCE (DISCONNECT FROM THE POWER SOCKET)

A. Disassemble the back panel

a. Remove the screws in the back panel first, then pull the back panel up.

b. Pull out the bottom of the back panel then take it down.

B. Drain the water tank

Remove drain plug and clear all water out from the tank by slightly tilting the unit to it's side.






KEY OPERATIONAL POINTS

- 1. Your cooler must be positioned near an open window or door to operate effectively.
- 2. Having a well-ventilated area/room is always best for air cooler usage.

- 3. Ensure the filter & cooling pads are always kept clean.
- 4. If storing the air cooler for a longer period:
- (a) Drain the tank and wipe it dry.
- (b) Clean the filter & cooling pad
- (c) Reassemble and run on "FAN ONLY" for 30 minutes to dry out the cooling pad

LOCATION

Having completed assembly of your cooler, position the unit with its back to an open window or door. This will allow fresh air to be drawn through the cooler and released throughout the room. Constant air change is an essential part of using air coolers and will be beneficial for your health & well-being.



WHEELS ASSEMBLY

Take out the 4 wheels and screws after opening the carton, install them at the bottom of the tank and move the air cooler smoothly.
